

Invasive plant control - King County Lake Stewardship program 2008:

- (1) On-going eradication of *Hydrilla verticillata* at Pipe and Lucerne Lakes. Last year (2007) was the first year since 1994 that no hydrilla plants were found during all diver/snorkel surveys carried out through the growing period.
- (2) On-going eradication of 4 noxious weeds at Spring Lake: Eurasian watermilfoil, fragrant waterlily, purple loosestrife, and yellow flag iris. This project has been active every summer since 2003.
- (3) We intend to begin a project in 2008 to eradicate Eurasian watermilfoil from Cottage Lake, with an accompanying control project for fragrant water lilies in order to make the milfoil control activities more effective.
